# TOYS

Before you put in a wish for toys (including sensory toys), make sure you've read the below to make sure everyone stays as safe as possible

## Keep it legal

All toys must comply with the following standards:

- British Standards BS5665
- European Standard EN71
- European Toy Safety Directive 2009/48/EC

The CE Mark is required by law on all toys sold within the European Union. It does not indicate quality or safety.

### Shop safe

Find your toy from a reputable outlet, preferably one with a 'front door' (i.e. Smyths Toys or The Entertainer). Remeber to include a link to the product in your wish.

## Age appropriate

Check the age range and make sure it's appropriate for the children who will be playing with it.

Always adhere to warnings from the manufacturer.

### Follow instructions!

Always follow the manufacturers' instructions.

#### **Check Check Check!**

Check the toys regularly for anything that has been damaged or is dirty, and remove these toys immediately.

#### Keep it clean!

Work with Housekeeping and the IPC team to create a cleaning schedule for the toys.

The most important way to prevent cross transmission of organisms is to encourage children to carry out hand hygiene before and after handling toys.

## Children must be supervised by a parent, guardian or carer whilst playing with these toys in your setting.
